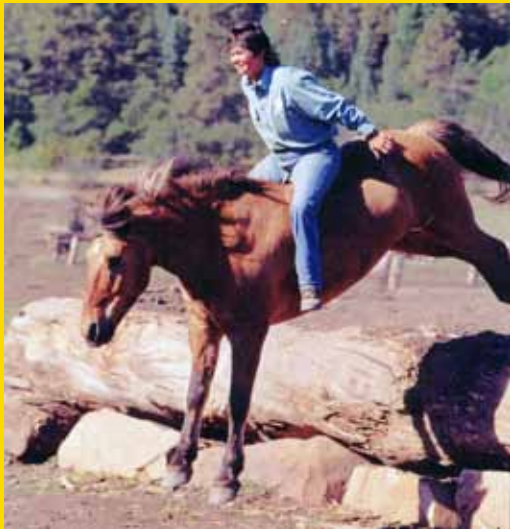


Horse Training:

Horsemanship Clinics

Marion offers clinics throughout British Columbia from Spring to Fall. She teaches in a private lesson format to focus on each individual. Marion's diverse foundation will help any discipline. Endless Possibilities

Topics may include but are not limited to: ground work with foals or adult horses, liberty training, riding lessons, specific problem solving, colt starting, gaited horses, English, Western, Natural or Vaquero horsemanship, driving, trail, or even stock management for camping.



Apprenticeship Program

This 4-5 week program is designed for Marion to share knowledge with future horse trainers and riding instructors.

Learn: Marion's approach to start a colt for riding including ground work in hand and at liberty.

Teach: horses to drive including driving single, double, in the arena and out on roads and trails.

Learn: how to become a certified CHA Instructor including making lesson plans and teaching others.

Develop: your own skills including working with your own horse to advance training or have riding lessons.

Learn: about camping with horses including putting a pack on a horse, hobble training, high lining, and knots.

Explore: the beautiful countryside on trail rides.

Learn: how to problem solve on people-spoiled horses.
